## Notional FirstNet Approach in the Draft RFP Documents – Current State















  - Remediates issues through contractual terms







## To Maximize Industry Participation, FirstNet Encourages Teaming to Meet all Program Objectives




- Due to the complexity of the acquisition, in order to achieve the "nationwide" objectives established by FirstNet it may be beneficial for potential offerors to consider partnering/teaming opportunities
  - Partnering/teaming may assist those offerors who do not have the capabilities to meet all of the objectives on their own
- FirstNet is compiling a list of potential offerors who may be interested in subcontracting and partnering opportunities with other potential offerors
  - It is not required to be included on this list in order to submit a proposal to any resultant RFP
  - This process is optional and solely intended to be an avenue to facilitate potential subcontracting and partnering opportunities
  - FirstNet accepts no liability for any resultant outcomes
  - Detailed instructions are in the Special Notice on FBO

 Key objective for the FirstNet acquisition is to promote competition and ensure a fair opportunity for all potential offerors
